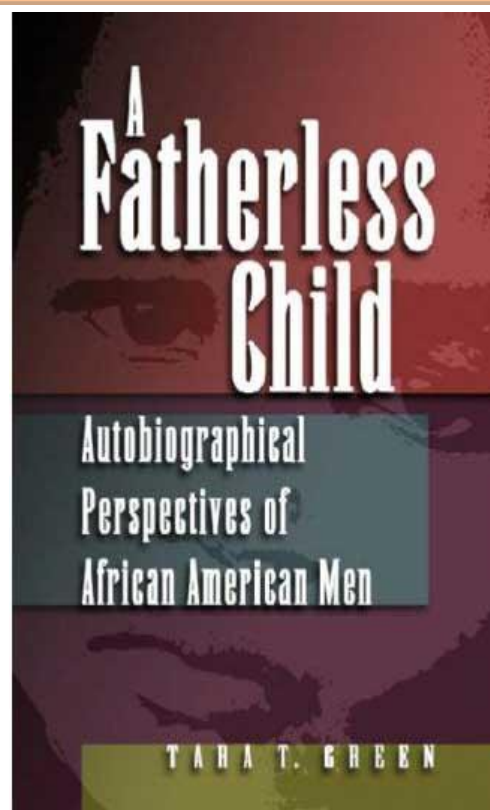

Autobiographical Perspectives of
African American Men.***



***A Fatherless Child* examines the impact of fatherlessness on racial and gender identity formation as seen in black men's autobiographies and in other constructions of black fatherhood in fiction. Through these works, Tara T. Green investigates what comes of abandonment by a father and the role of community in forming the son's black identity. Dr. Green is Associate Professor and Director of the African American Studies Program.**
