## **66 Inducted into Business Honor Society at UNCG**

**GREENSBORO** – Fifty-four students from the Joseph M. Bryan School of Business and Economics at The University of North Carolina at Greensboro were inducted on Tuesday, April 17, into the Beta Gamma Sigma national honor society.

Beta Gamma Sigma (BGS) is the national scholastic honor society for business students. Qualifying for membership is the highest scholastic honor a student in business can attain. To be eligible, students must rank in the upper ten percent of their junior or senior class, or the upper twenty percent of their graduate class.

Students inducted into BGS must attend schools that are accredited by AACSB International, the Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business. Membership in BGS is open to students in all accredited Bryan School programs, which include all Bachelor and Master of Science, Master of Business Administration and PhD in Information Systems.

Eleven members of the Bryan School faculty were also inducted. Faculty can join BGS if they have an earned doctorate from an AACSB-accredited business school or if they have been with the Bryan School for six or more years.

M. Lee McAllister, president and CEO of Weaver Investment Company in Greensboro, chair of the Greensboro Partnership Board of Directors and a member of the Bryan School Advisory Board, was inducted as an honorary member of BGS.
