Classes meet from 8:15 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. in Room 122 of the Bryan School of Business and Economics (516 Stirling Street) on the UNCG campus. Lunch break is from 12:00 p.m. to 1:00 p.m.

Payment Plan for Complete Course

A payment plan is available to students enrolled for the complete course. One third payment is due on the first day of class. The 2/3 remaining balance is divided into three equal payments due by the 15th of each month. No interest is charged as long as payments are received on time. If the account becomes delinquent an interest charge will be applied to the outstanding balance at the APR of 12%. All payments are due by the last day of class.

Refund Policy

A withdrawal fee of \$25.00 will be charged for all withdrawals. For those registered for all four parts, tuition (less the cost of materials) will be prorated if withdrawal notice is given in the

first six weeks of class. The date of the written notice of intent to withdraw is the effective date of the withdrawal. No refund is available after the first six weeks.

Repeat Plan

Students are entitled to repeat any section(s) of the course at a substantial discount. The discounted price is good for one year following completion of the section. This fee is for tuition only; books and updated software may be purchased for \$35 each.

Carryover Credit

Students who pay for the course in one semester and decide to carryover a part to a future semester have 12 months within which to use the carryover credit.
