Other Other Notable Facts

Last year's graduating seniors outscored two-thirds of the test takers on a national assessment test conducted by Educational Testing Service. The test measures undergraduates' knowledge of business in the areas of accounting, economics, management, business analysis, finance, marketing, legal and social issues, and international issues.

The *Center for Global Business Education and Research* supports student and faculty exchanges with schools in 35 countries. It also assists local organizations with international programming.

The School works with 14 *student organizations* including honor societies, national societies, and service organizations. The Bryan School has a Premier Chapter of Beta Gamma Sigma, the worldwide honor society that represents the highest recognition a student can receive in a business program accredited by AACSB International.

The School publishes the *Journal of Global Information Technology Management*, one of the most prestigious academic journals in its field and hosts their annual international conference.
