Using CareerLeader



CareerLeader is the only assessment that was designed (by career psychologists at the Harvard Business School) for students pursuing careers in business and is used by 230 top business schools. The program measures the three most important parts of you as you consider different careers: **your interests, your abilities, and what motivates you**. It will provide feedback to you on what careers are likely to make for a good fit (based on its assessment of your interests, motivators, and abilities) and what kind of organizational culture you will be most comfortable and successful in. It also contains information about those careers and different industries, interviewing tips, and more.

Please note the servers are case sensitive. From here you'll go through a quick (one minute) registration, and be able to take the tests right away. Once you complete a test, those results are available immediately, though the comprehensive Professional Report requires you to complete all three tests first. As you are taking the assessment, please remember that there are no right or wrong answers – your response should fit you.

So how will your CareerLeader results be used? As mentioned above, your CareerLeader results will include information about the following and will be used as part of the career coaching process:

- your core interests, and what they mean for your career success and happiness
- the kind of organizational culture you'll most likely enjoy and succeed in
- the rewards that tend to motivate you most
- your strengths and weaknesses (as you see them and as others see them)
- characteristics that may limit your success

All first year students enrolled in the full-time daytime MBA program are asked to complete the CareerLeader assessment during the first month of the program.
