TISEC INVESTMENTS:

Companies can become TISEC members by purchasing guaranteed seats to our seminars. The following information indicates the yearly cost based upon the number of seats (TISEC will offer three seminars per year – March, July and October).

If your firm reserved four seats, you could provide the opportunity for as many as four people to attend each of our three sessions per calendar year (at an average cost of \$150 per seminar per person).

Nonmembers can join us at any seminar for a cost of \$225 if you register by the deadline for that particular seminar. However, if you register after the event’s posted deadline, there is an additional late registration fee of \$50 per person.
