**University Information:** The University of Oulu was founded in 1958 and with its 16,000 students it is one of the largest universities in Finland. The main part of the University is called Linnanmaa and is located about 4 miles from the city center. The campus has modern classrooms, a large library and a sports center.



**Typical courses students can take:** GEC or business; Oulu offers a “Certificate in Managing Business Relationships.”

**Exchange semesters available:** Fall (August-December) or spring (January-June)

**Good for Majors in:** All Bryan majors, especially Business Studies and ECO-BA

**Grades:** Students need a minimum of a 2 to receive and transfer credits.

**Other comments:** With a population of 127,000, Oulu is the cultural, commercial and administrative center for central and northern Finland. The city is densely inhabited but the local transportation system is well developed. Because of the flat landscape, bicycles are common means of transportation. The Oulu region offers a wide variety of recreational activities such as swimming and winter-sports such as ice-skating and skiing. Students participating in spring semester exchange may be able to complete an internship.
