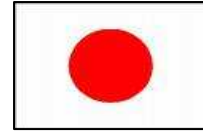




# Study Site Form

**University Information:** Seinan Gakuin University (SGU) consists of five departments with eleven divisions and four graduate schools. The combined enrollment is around 7,000 full-time students. One of the distinctive features of the university's educational program is its emphasis on internationalization. Through its international exchange program which was launched in 1971, exchanges take place between SGU and fifteen international universities.



**Typical courses students can take:** Most GEC and selected business courses in English.

**Exchange semesters available:** 1st Semester: January-May, 2nd Semester: August-December.

**Good for Majors in:** All Bryan School majors.

**GPA required or recommended:** 2.75+

**Housing options:** Home stay, campus housing or off-campus housing.

**Meet Foreign Language?:** Yes.

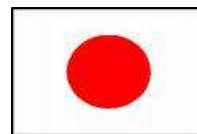
**Grades:** Students need a minimum of 60 to receive and transfer credit.



**Other comments:** Fukuoka City, the home of Seinan Gakuin and a metropolis of 1,300,000 people, is a city in the northern region of Kyushu. The university is located in Nishijin and Momochihama, a sub-center of the city. In recent years, this area has become known for its concentration of communication, business, and commercial enterprises, along with cultural and sports facilities such as the Fukuoka Dome, the City Public Library, and the City Museum.

The university's primary vision is to make a positive contribution to a rapidly-globalizing society. The university offers facilities for students to take part in numerous extracurricular activities such as cultural, academic and physical.
