**University Information:** The Université d'Angers was created in 1971 following the expansion of university centers throughout France. The total enrollment is 16,000. The University has a large modern campus southwest of Paris, between Nantes and Tours. Angers is one of the largest cities in the Loire Valley, about 90 minutes by rapid train from Paris.



**Typical courses students can take:** French language, some Business courses in English, some GEC.

**Exchange semesters available:** Semester and full year exchange available.

**Good for Majors in:** International Business.

**GPA required or recommended:** 2.75+

**Housing options:** Residence halls.

**Good for Majors in:** All Bryan School majors, especially marketing majors.

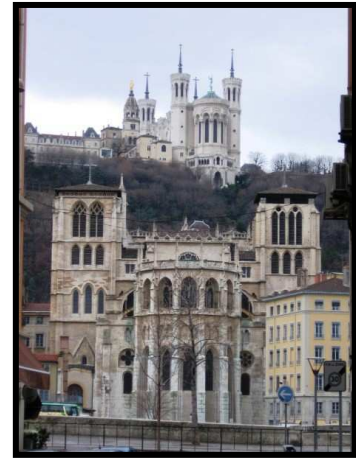
**GPA required or recommended:** 2.75+
