

Student Group Registration Classifications Checklist

All groups must achieve and maintain McIver in order to be a registered student group at UNCG. Groups must be registered in order to be a Recognized Student Group at UNCG.

Classifications are tracked and evaluated at the end of EACH semester.

All groups who wish to hold office space must complete and maintain Spartan Classification to be eligible to apply for office space (must have office space to receive key card access)

McIver

- ❑ Send representative to ONE Registration Kick Off meeting in the fall semester.
- ❑ Submit Annual Registration Form via COMMUNITY by stated deadline (due mid-September)
- ❑ Maintain accurate roster including officers/leadership positions on Community—MUST HAVE FIVE MEMBERS
- ❑ Maintain full time, on-campus advisor
- ❑ Head Officers must maintain a cumulative 2.5 GPA
- ❑ Submit the End of Semester Survey (ESS) on the last day of class each semester

Spartan

- ❑ Complete all components of McIver
- ❑ Attend Leadership Academy in the Fall; attend the Emerging Leaders Conference in the Spring
- ❑ Complete 2 Educational Programs each semester—AT LEAST ONE will be presented by Spartans Leading Spartans (SLS) - (bring SLS to group OR attend Operation U-Lead workshop)
- ❑ Organization engages in 1 community service project each semester (*50% of your membership must be involved in project*)

Minerva

- ❑ Complete all components of McIver
- ❑ Attend Leadership Academy in the Fall; attend the Emerging Leaders Conference in the Spring
- ❑ Complete 4 Educational Programs each semester—AT LEAST TWO will be presented by Spartans Leading Spartans (SLS) - (bring SLS to group OR attend Operation U-Lead workshops)
- ❑ Average group GPA is 2.5
- ❑ Organization engages in 2 community service projects each semester (*50% of your membership must be involved in project*)

- GPA will be checked for those groups up for “Minerva” categorization
- All head officers GPA will be checked after each semester
- When a group does not achieve McIver, the group will not be registered and therefore not recognized at UNCG for the rest of the academic year
- **If a group is appealing the decision —they remain registered and recognized until decision is made**
- All classifications will be published (website, Excellence Banquet, Carolinian, etc) throughout the year.
- Each semester—groups will be selected at random to “audit” educational programs and community service projects/hours
