### 1. PRINCIPLE PARTS:

### 2. TRANSLATIONS of the INDICATIVE:

	ACTIVE	PASSIVE
Present (Aorist/Progressive):	I release, I am releasing	I am (being) released
Past (Progressive):	I was/kept releasing, I used to release	I was being released
Future (Aorist/Progressive):	I will release, I will be releasing	I will be released
(Past) Aorist:	I released, I did release	I was released
Present Perfect:	I have released	I have been released
Past Perfect:	I had released	I had been released

	action in progress	action not yet started	simple or single occurrence	completed action
<b>4. STEMS:</b>	[λυ-]	[λυσ-]	[λυσσ- / λυθ-]	[λελυκ- / λελυ-]

### 6. TRANSLATIONS of the INFINITIVE:

	ACTIVE	PASSIVE
Progressive:	to keep releasing, to be releasing	to keep being released
Future:	to be about to release	to be about to be released
Aorist:	to release	to be released
Perfect:	to have released	to have been released
