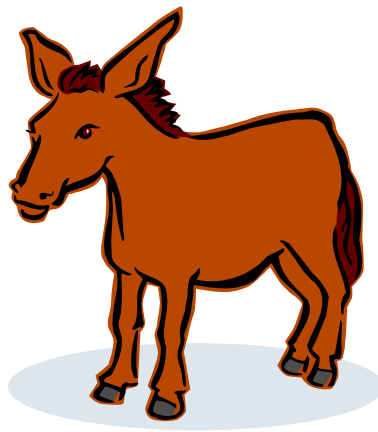


# Parable of the Good Samaritan
