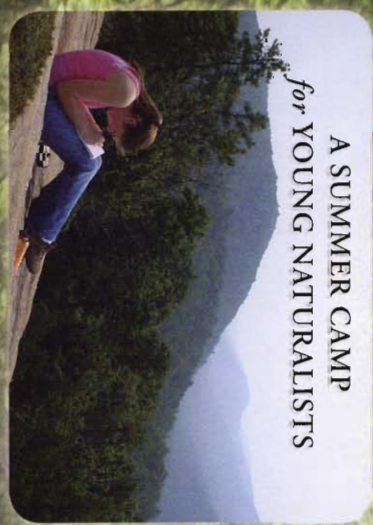

to The Green River

Preserve, a non-profit, co-ed natural science camp with one, two, and three week sessions for rising 4th through 9th grades and expedition programs for high school students in rising 9th through 12th grades.



Located in the Blue Ridge Mountains of Western North Carolina, the private wildlife preserve encompasses 3,400 acres of mountain terrain including streams, trails, campsites, caves, and multiple waterfalls. Purchased in the early 1950's by the Schenck family as a private retreat, the camp is now

owned and operated by the camp's founder, Sandy Schenck and his wife Missy.

An American Camp Association accredited camp, Green River offers campers the opportunity to explore hidden forests, wade in trout streams and pick wild blueberries as they hike to mountain over-looks ... all with professional naturalists. They enjoy excellent food, outstranding facilities, campfires with music and stories and a wide variety of elective activities. Most importantly, campers thrive in a nurturing, creative community that shares a fascination with nature. Friendships flourish, self-confidence grows, and skills are developed.

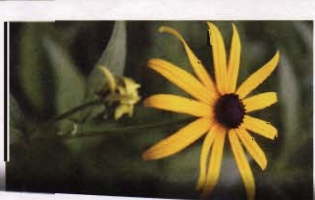
What makes Green River unique?

Expeditions: 14-Day co-ed, wilderness skills development and backpacking program.

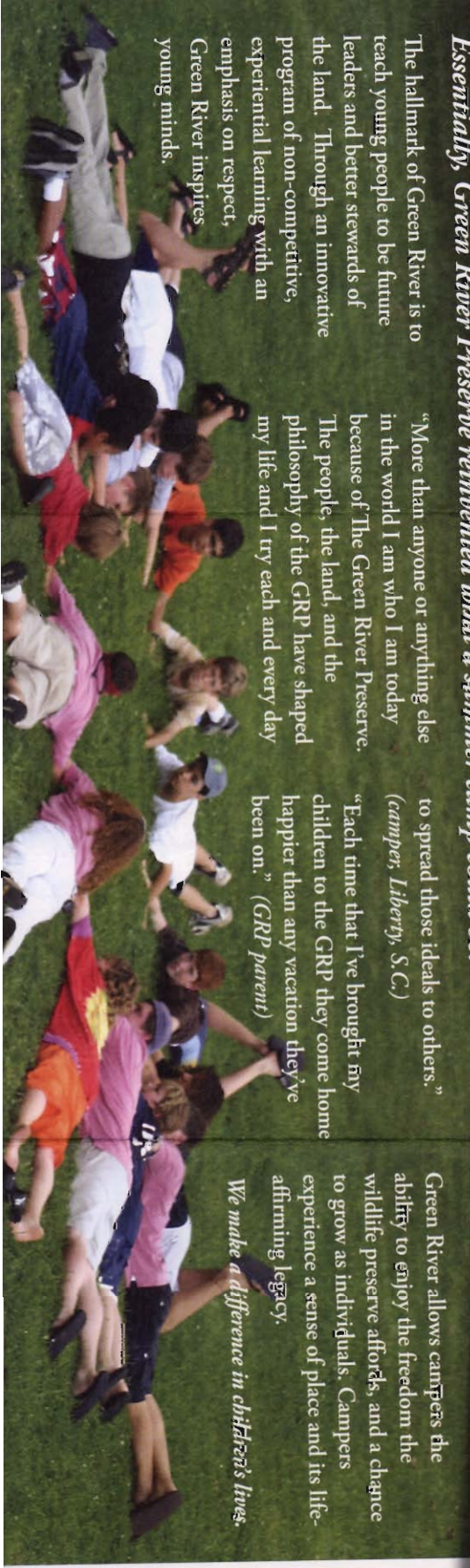
Heightens confidence,
