## **Duty Station:**

Rocky Mountain Arsenal National Wildlife Refuge is located just ten miles northeast of downtown Denver, the refuge is the largest contiguous open space in the Denver metropolitan area. The site finished a major environmental restoration program in October 2011 and has become one of the largest urban national wildlife refuges in the United States. ## **General Duties:**

- ✓ Assist with overall fishing program
- ✓ Co-lead and provide support for public fishing programs
- ✓ Support fishing programs with Craig's Hospital and Children's Hospital
- ✓ Research and order all fishing equipment needed
- ✓ Development and implement at least 1 interpretive fishing workshop for the general public
- ✓ Monitor the monofilament recycling program
- ✓ Assist with overall trail program
- ✓ Construct trails and assist with maintenance of trails
- ✓ Help with scout programs, workshops and events
- ✓ Research and update scout backpack activities for onsite checkout that correlates with badge requirements.
- ✓ Involvement in special events such as Fishing Frenzy, Wild Walk, and Refuge Roundup
- ✓ Contribute to website revisions specifically regarding the fishing pages

## **Other Duties:**

- ✓ Assist other divisions with projects when schedule permits
- ✓ Support other areas such environmental education, visitor center staffing, and other public use programs
- ✓ Staff outreach booths, lead outreach activities, and presentations
