



## Vermont's Best Outdoor Jobs!

This year, the Vermont Youth Conservation Corps will hire over 200 young adults to work on high priority conservation projects throughout the state of Vermont. The VYCC has a variety of opportunities, which suit a wide range of experience levels and backgrounds. The following is a description of the positions that we have available for the 2009 season.

**Please display the enclosed poster in a prominent location and make this information available to any students who may be interested in our positions.**

**Park Educator-** This is a nine month long AmeriCorps position running from mid March through mid December and is based out of a Vermont State Park. The Park Educator will be responsible for providing environmental educational programs to park visitors as well as the daily operations and maintenance of the Park.

**Park Crew Leaders-** This is a six month long position beginning in the middle of April for individuals who are at least 22 years of age. Some Park Crew Leaders will be responsible for the overall management, day to day operations and maintenance of a Vermont State Park. Other Park Crew Leaders will be responsible for running educational programs, teaching both life and job skills, as well as cultivating a community for Park Crew Members.

**Park Crew Members-** There are residential and non-residential opportunities for individuals who are at least 17 years of age to help run the daily operations and maintenance of a Vermont State Park while participating in educational discussions and developing land stewardship skills.

---

**Wilderness, Roving and Community Crew Leaders-** Crew Leader positions are for individuals at least 22 years of age, with previous experience in leadership, outdoor education, or completion of conservation projects. Crew Leaders will be responsible for building a community, ensuring the health and safety of their crew, and teaching both life and job skills. Crew Leaders will also be responsible for professionally managing work projects and ensuring high-quality standards.

**Summer Corps Members-** Corps Member positions are for individuals who are 16-24 years of age. Corps Members will work on small crews completing high-priority environmental conservation projects across the state of Vermont on a Wilderness, a Roving, or a Community Crew. Each summer, VYCC crews restore trails, streams, historical sites and natural areas.
