### **Average Program costs (including tuition, fees, room and board, books and supplies, etc.)**

Using the 2011 Fall Semester Preliminary Fall Semester 2011 of Tuition and Fee Charges the Average Program costs were calculated assuming that the student completes the program in three semesters. The following assumes the graduate student will take 7 credit hours fall semester, 6 credit hours in the spring semester and three credit hours (internship) during the summer semester.

The estimated Average Program cost for instate students range from \$5,400 to \$5,900 and the out-of-state estimated Average Program costs range from \$17,550 to \$17,950. ### **Number of students who completed GRO Certificate during the 2010-2011 academic year only**

Four (4) students completed the GRO Certificate during the 2010-2011 academic year with a 75% "on time" completion rate. Of the students who completed the Gerontology Certificate during the 2010-2011 academic year 50% went on to the Master of Science in Gerontology program, 25% went on to program management and instruction for a medical school, and 25% went into county employment.
