The BK:ISED program has received a federal grant to help prepare graduate level early childhood educators.

Once accepted into the BK:ISED program, students can receive **FREE TUITION AND FEES** if they are US citizens with in-state residency status. Full-time students will also receive a stipend to cover additional expenses.

**All applicants will be considered,** however, first priority will be given to individuals from under-represented populations, particularly students with disabilities, who have a family member with a disability, or who are from culturally and linguistically diverse backgrounds

**Students who are enrolled in the grant supported BK:ISED program will participate in the following additional experiences:**

- \* **3 practicum experiences**
- \* **professional development seminars**
- \* **classes related to cultural competence and diversity**
- \* **mentoring program**

**Students who receive financial support must agree to work with children with disabilities for two years upon completion of the program for every one year of full-time funding received.**
