If you wish to be considered for merit-based scholarships only, you need not complete the FAFSA. Final scholarship awards will be determined by departmental faculty representatives. UNIVERSITY POLICY: A scholarship recipient must be enrolled as a full-time student (Undergraduate – 12 hours; Graduate - 6 hours). Scholarship recipients must be declared majors in the School of HES; changing your major to an area outside of HES will result in cancellation of your scholarship. A scholarship is granted for one academic year only, for the period of August through May. Scholarships in excess of \$750 awarded will be split in half with one-half applied in fall 2009 and one-half applied in spring 2010.
