Some scholarships are based on academic merit alone while others are based on merit and/or financial need. Final scholarship awards will be determined by departmental faculty representatives.

UNIVERSITY POLICY: A scholarship recipient must be enrolled as a full-time student (Undergraduate – 12 hours; Graduate - 6 hours). Scholarship recipients must be declared majors in the School of HES. A scholarship is granted for one academic year only, for the period of August through May. One-half will be awarded for the first semester and one-half for the second semester.

If you are chosen to receive a scholarship that has a financial need associated with the scholarship and your FAFSA does not demonstrate financial need, the School of HES is under no obligation to award the scholarship.
