Problem of the 21st Century?**

Dr. Blair is a Fellow in the American College of Epidemiology, Society for Behavioral Medicine, American College of Sports Medicine, American Heart Association, and American Academy of Kinesiology and Physical Education. He has delivered lectures to medical, scientific, and lay groups in 49 states and 49 countries. His research focuses on the associations between lifestyle and health, with a specific emphasis on exercise, physical fitness, body composition, and chronic disease. He has published over 500 papers and chapters in the scientific literature, and is one of the most highly cited exercise scientists, with over 25,000 citations to his work. He also was the Senior Scientific Editor for the U.S. Surgeon General's Report on Physical Activity and Health.
