



Colorzilla

Introduction

Colorzilla is a free plugin for the Mozilla Firefox browser that enables you to identify any color in a web page. That color is displayed in hexadecimal and in RGB codes. Colorzilla is useful when you are trying to match the colors in a Google Site theme or in an image you are using as a header.

This handout explains how to obtain and use Colorzilla.

Download Colorzilla

1. Go to <https://addons.mozilla.org/> and search for Colorzilla.
2. Click Add to Firefox and then Install.
3. Click Restart Firefox.

Use Colorzilla

1. Navigate to a page that contains a color you wish to identify.
2. Click the little eye dropper in the left hand corner of the browser bottom taskbar.
3. Your cursor should turn into a cross.
4. As you mouse over different areas in the browser, you should see your RGB numbers (Red, Green, Blue) and your hexadecimal code (the 6-digit code preceded by a #) change.
5. Record the color you wish and apply it as needed.
