



Google Sites Site Appearance

Introduction

There are multiple options for customizing the look of your Google Site. Google provides themes, site layout options (width, header, sidebar), logo, navigation, and colors and fonts for various aspects of the Site.

Themes

To set a theme for your Google Site

1. Click More Actions (upper right) > Manage Site.
2. Under Site Appearance, click Themes.
3. Select a theme and click Save changes.

Site Layout

To change layout options for your Google Site

1. Click More Actions (upper right) > Manage Site.
2. Under Site Appearance, click Site Layout. Modify
 - a. Site width (in pixels or percent)
 - b. Header (no header, theme default value, logo size, or define in pixels)
 - c. Sidebar (no sidebar, left, right, width).
3. Click OK and Save changes.

To change the logo

1. Click More Actions (upper right) > Manage Site.
2. Under Site Appearance, click the change logo link in the Header area.
3. Select No logo or Custom Logo (to upload one).
4. Click OK and Save changes.

Colors and Fonts

If you decide to accept the theme default value, you do not need to set any of these. If you want to experiment further

1. Click More Actions (upper right) > Manage Site.
2. Under Site Appearance, click Colors and Fonts.
3. Select an item in the drop down box and then select Custom and select a color or enter a hexadecimal code in the box.
4. Click Save changes.
