UNCG's Eta Delta chapter of the **Phi Beta Delta International Scholars Honor Society** invites nominations of UNCG **FACULTY and STAFF** to be inducted into the society. **Phi Beta Delta** is an international honor society that supports institutions of higher education commitment to internationalizing the educational experience for its students, faculty, and staff.

Nominees must demonstrate their participation in fostering or partaking in international experiences while employed at UNCG for a minimum of ONE full year. Nominations are reviewed annually by the International and Global Studies Program committee. To be selected for induction, nominees must meet the following criteria:

- experience in leading students on study abroad programs, and/or
- experience teaching or doing research/creative activity or service that takes them overseas for extended periods of time, and/or
- experience teaching, or doing research/creative activity or service that substantially contributes to internationalization across the campus.

Faculty and staff may be nominated by the head of a department or program, or by any member of the faculty or staff who has worked at UNCG in a full-time capacity for at least TWO consecutive years. Also, nominators are limited to TWO nominations per year, and no department or program may have more than TWO nominees in a single year. *(Please note: Faculty and staff selected for membership pay one-time "new member" dues of \$50. Further details will be provided upon notification of selection.)*

Nomination Materials

Each nomination must include the following:

- A completed nomination form;
- A curriculum vitae (résumé) highlighting the nominee's specific qualifications for the award;
- A supporting letter from a member of the faculty or staff who has worked at UNCG in a full-time capacity for at least TWO consecutive years and that speaks to the contributions that the nominee's teaching, research/creative activity, or service have made to internationalizing the academic careers of UNCG students and the university, **and/or** the importance that the nominee's international experience has played in his or her teaching, research/creative activity, or service.
