*Graduate international students are required to take a minimum of 6 credit hours per semester. However, hours and tuition may vary depending on the program of study.

**Cost of Books & Supplies can vary by program. For example, in music and nursing programs, additional expenses may be necessary.

A \$70 per-credit hour Tuition differential is charged for all MBA courses MSA courses and for 600 level MSITM courses.

Additional Expenses: Dependents (living expenses for spouse and/or child under 21 years old) \$ 5,200.00 each dependent per academic year.

Tuition and fees are paid to the University at the time of registration each semester. For instance, a payment of approximately \$ 7,815 is due upon registration at the beginning of each semester (undergraduate students) and approximately \$ 7,724 (graduate students).

In the event friends or relatives provide accommodation and meals for the duration of your program of study, you may subtract the equivalent value per year of US \$5,850 from the total minimum budget amount. Please indicate in the financial certificate form that accommodation will be provided by friends or relatives. You must submit a letter of support indicating that room and meals will be provided. The letter must be signed by your relatives or friends and provided along with the financial certificate form, Affidavit of Support, and bank statement.

Please note that the information listed above is based on average living expenses and on-campus accommodations. Actual expenses may vary according to individual choices.
