



**Required Minimum Budget for
 International Undergraduate Students
 Academic Year 2011-2012**

Certain expenses are paid directly to the University while other expenses such as laptop and personal expenses are paid directly to the vendor or service provider.

*Cost of books and supplies can vary by program. For example, in music and nursing programs, additional expenses may be necessary.
Additional Expenses: Dependents (living expenses for spouse and/or child under 21 years old); \$5,200.00 each dependent per academic year.
Tuition and fees are paid to the University at the time of registration each semester. For instance, a payment of approximately \$9009.00 is due upon registration at the beginning of each semester for undergraduate students.
Room rate is based on campus double occupancy. If a relative or friend provides <u>accommodation and meals</u> for the duration of your program of study, you may subtract the equivalent value per year of <u>US \$6,452</u> from the total minimum budget amount, making the total budget amount <u>\$22,009</u> . Please indicate on the financial certificate form that accommodation will be provided by a relative or friend. The relative or friend must submit a letter of support indicating that room and meals will be provided. The letter must be signed by your relative or friend and provided along with the Financial Certificate form, Affidavit of Support, and bank letter and statement.
Please note that the information listed above is based on average living expenses and on-campus accommodations. Actual expenses may vary according to individual choices.
