Charge: The UNCG Study Abroad Committee

Approved by the Office of Provost, November, 1993, and Revised September, 2000.

The UNCG Study Abroad Committee is a campus- wide Committee of faculty members with considerable experience in international education. The purpose of the Committee is to ensure the quality of the University's Study Aboard programs.

These programs include: semester and academic year abroad; one-for-one student exchanges; the International Student Exchange Program; Summer Abroad; and all internally and externally sponsored programs overseas in which UNCG students might participate.

The Committee shall reviews new programs for educational integrity, quality of total experience and safety. It will also monitor on-going programs to ensure their continuing quality. The Committee will, where appropriate, actively develop new programs.

The Committee will be advisory to the UNCG International Programs Center on administrative matters, and to the UNCG Undergraduate Curriculum Committee on academic matters. In particular, and acting on behalf of the Curriculum Committee, the Study Abroad Committee will counsel Student Academic Services and appropriate academic departments to resolve issues of academic credit as they arise.

The Committee shall be University-wide in composition. It will be appointed by the Provost upon the recommendation of the Associate Provost for the International Programs and will make regular reports to the UNCG International Programs Advisory Committee. The chair of the Study Abroad Committee will be a member of the International Programs Advisory Committee. The Committee shall meet at regular intervals, and not less than twice per semester. It will provide to the UNCG Associate Provost for the International Programs on an annual basis a report detailing its actions and making recommendations as appropriate. The staff work for the Committee shall be provided by the International Programs Center.
