

Position: Graduate Assistant Athletic Trainer

Category: College-Part-time/Graduate Assistant/Intern

Description:

Greensboro College seeks applicants for THREE (3) positions of Graduate Assistant Athletic Trainer to begin in August of 2010. The selected candidate will be part of a growing CAATE approved curriculum and serve as an Approved Clinical Instructor after proper training has been completed. The position will require coverage of the athletic training room, team assignments (including travel), administrative, and other duties as assigned. Candidates should possess strong independence and desire to work autonomously while remaining focused on the growth mission and vision of the program, the college and our profession.

State licensure and NATA dues paid for by the college. Remuneration in the amount of \$10,000 will be paid over the 10 month contract which will be evaluated and renewed on an annual basis. Paid medical insurance included in position. During overlap periods (Fall to Winter and Winter to Spring) of play, overtime will required and paid accordingly to federal regulatory standards within budgetary limits set by the college. Early applicants who commit to position MAY qualify for housing depending on need. Partial meal plan paid for by college as well.

Students that are interested in continuing their education in graduate work can seek enrollment at either Greensboro College or one of several area colleges/universities in the community. Currently Greensboro College offers the following five Post-Baccalaureate and Masters degree programs;
