Membership fees and contributions provide much needed funds for a special annual project which is carefully selected in cooperation with the Dean. Funds for past projects have included the purchase of a tuba and fortepiano, the creation and production of a School of Music informational and recruiting brochure, state-of-the art practice rooms which create the ambience of great performance halls throughout the world, electronic signage on Market Street, the upgrading of classrooms and lecture halls with equipment to allow electronic and computer integrated presentations, and the contribution to the purchase of a celeste for School of Music and community performances. In 2007-2008, seven UNCG music students received scholarship endowment funds from the Guild.

The UNCG School of Music has been recognized for years as one of the top music institutions in the United States and one of the foremost schools in the South. Music has been a central discipline at UNCG since the university's founding over a century ago. Progressing from a department to a professional School of Music, the School was the first institution in the South to offer an undergraduate music education degree (1912). During the 1920's, the North Carolina High School Music Contest Festival—the precursor of today's influential North Carolina Music Educators Association—arose on campus. The School has been fully accredited by the National Association of Schools of Music since 1938.



Today, the School offers the only comprehensive music program from undergraduate through doctoral study in performance and music education in the state. More than 60 faculty teach an overall student body of 600 students.

### *First Annual Moveable Musical Feast Raises Over \$10,000 for the School of Music*

Over 100 patrons toured the world with the School of Music on Sunday, May 4, during the First Annual Moveable Musical Feast. The School was transformed into New Orleans, Paris, Milan and New York, with guests enjoying an evening filled with themed treats and great music from School of Music faculty and students. Proceeds benefitted the Musical Arts Guild Scholarship Fund and Annual Project. This year's event is scheduled for Sunday, May 9, 2009, and promises to be filled with just as much adventure.
