

DIETETIC INTERNSHIP APPLICATION PROCEDURES FOR COMPUTER MATCHING PROCESS:

The UNCG Dietetic Internship is Participating in the Centralized Application System for the Spring 2012 Computer Matching Process (DICAS)

- The UNCG Dietetic Internship program is using the on-line centralized internship application, DICAS, which may be accessed at <https://portal.dicas.org> , e-mail DICASinfo@DICAS.org. DICAS will be available in early December 2011 for the Spring 2012 Match. The on-line application must be completed for our program by 11:59 p.m. Central Time on February 15, 2012. The fee to use DICAS is \$40 for the **first** DI application submitted and \$20 for **each additional** dietetic internship program application.
- When completing the application form, applicants must include the name and contact information (specifically an e-mail address) for each reference. This will trigger an e-mail message requesting completion of a reference form. The form will be completed on-line. Students submitting more than one application will need to use the same individuals as references for each application.
- Applicants who apply to internships using DICAS will be asked to complete a personal statement. Questions to be addressed in the personal statement include:
 - Why do you want to enter the dietetics profession?
 - Discuss experiences that have helped to prepare you for your career,
 - What are your short-term and long-term goals?
 - What are your strengths and weaknesses or areas needing improvement?
 - 1000 Word limit
- Official **transcripts from all colleges and universities attended** should be sent to

- Applicants must register online for computer matching at www.dnndigital.com and select dietetic internship priority choices by 11:59 p.m. Central Time on February 15. There is a \$50.00 computer matching fee.
- Submit the UNCG Supplemental Application and \$55 application fee (make check payable to Department of Nutrition, Dietetic Internship, UNCG); mail to Dietetic Internship, Department of Nutrition, UNC Greensboro, 318 Stone Building, Greensboro, NC 27402-6170.
- GPA of 3.0 is required to be competitive with a minimum of B (3.0) in dietetics courses
- GRE scores are required as part of the application
- UNCG Campus Safety Questions must be completed and submitted as part of the UNCG Supplemental Application
- Selection is based on academics, experiences, personal statement, and letters of recommendation
