Internally Funded URE Opportunities

Undergraduate Research

Assistantships (URA) offers highly motivated students the opportunity to work closely with a faculty member on his/her research, scholarship, or creative activity.

Community-Based Research

(CbURA) involves faculty and students working collaboratively with community partners to research issues of common concern. A collaboration with UNCG's OSLSL.

Entrepreneurial Research

Assistantship (EnURA) Working with a small business owner, students resolve "problems" by doing research for the business.

Interdisciplinary Research

Assistantship (IdURA) Faculty and students work across disciplinary lines to create and disseminate knowledge in new areas of scholarship and research.

OUR Travel Fund up to \$350

Only available for students supported by URA, CbURA, EnURA and/or IdURA. Provides student support to present the results of their work at professional conferences in their field.



Externally Funded URE Opportunities

NSF funded Math/Biology Fellowships

Open to Mathematics and Biology students who work as teams, co-mentored by faculty in mathematics and biology. The goal is to generate new knowledge at the interface of mathematics and biology.

NSF funded REU Interdisciplinary Quantitative Science

Students work closely with faculty mentors and other undergraduate research students on projects at the intersection of mathematics, physics, chemistry or biology.
