

High School Deficiency Sequence Worksheet

If you are missing **ANY** of the minimum course requirements (MCR) from high school or if you have a GED, you must meet one of the following requirements to become eligible for admission:

- Complete the following sequence of thirty semester hours from a regionally accredited institution of higher education that will be creditable toward a degree at UNCG. You must have six semester hours (2 classes) with “C” or better work in **EACH** of the following subject areas:

English

Mathematics

Natural Science

Social and Behavioral Science (sociology, psychology, anthropology, economics, political science, history, archaeology)

Foreign Language (may include sign language)

Please note: Students who graduated from high school prior to 2004 may substitute other college transfer electives for the foreign language courses in this sequence.

OR

- Earn a Transfer Readiness diploma from a North Carolina Community College;

OR

- Graduate from a regionally accredited two-year institution with an Associate in Arts, Associate in Science, or Associate in Fine Arts degree. An Associate of Applied Science degree does not meet this requirement.
