

## **Degree Evaluation (WebCAPP) for Advisors Frequently Asked Questions**

### **Who can use the degree evaluation (WebCAPP)?**

All advisors will have access to view the General Education Core requirements for their advisees. Advisors in the Bryan School of Business and Economics and the School of Nursing will also be able to see major requirements. Students do not have access at this time.

The degree evaluation (WebCAPP) applies to students enrolled for the FIRST time (transfer and freshman) Fall 2001 and beyond. Students enrolled prior to Fall 2001 (including reactivated or readmitted students) will continue to use the paper degree audits even if they are following GEC/GEC+CAR. Again, the student's catalog term does not indicate eligibility to use the degree evaluation.

### **The courses that are required for GEC in our major/concentration are not listed specifically under the GEC requirements as they are on the paper degree audit. Why??**

The GEC requirements are the same for all students. The courses that fulfill major requirements and GEC are listed specifically under the major, concentration, or cognate requirements. Departments may want to develop advising companions to assist students with course selection including information regarding courses that meet more than one requirement.

### **My advisee is a second degree student or fulfilled the requirements of the Common Articulation Agreement at the community college. How will CAPP reflect their general education requirements?**

The GEC requirements for these students will be reflected on the degree evaluation. The advisor will see a field that lists "Second Degree" or "Common Articulation Agreement" as appropriate.

### **My advisee has a GEC waiver of a Global, Global Non Western, Writing Intensive, or Speaking Intensive marker based on transfer hours at point of entry. It does not appear on the degree evaluation. Why??**

The Registrar's Office updated the GEC waivers for students enrolled for the first time Fall 2001 and beyond. Please contact Student Academic Services for clarification regarding these waivers.

### **My advisee should have a departmental waiver or substitution (School of Nursing and Bryan School of Business and Economics only) that does not appear on the degree evaluation. Why??**

The Registrar's Office updated all known substitutions and waivers. If one does not appear, please submit the substitution/waiver form to Student Academic Services.
