



Summer Stipends

DUE: 5 pm Thursday, August 28, 2008

The Office of Sponsored Programs

This program provides a stipend of \$6,000 for two consecutive months of full-time research and writing.

Eligible Applicants:

- Full-time faculty members (instructor → professor)
- US citizens
- Foreign nationals (living in US jurisdiction for the last three years)
- Not a previous Summer Stipend Recipient (during or after 2004)
- Not the recipient of a “major” grant (\$10,000 or more) in the last three years

What to Submit:

- A narrative description of the proposed project not to exceed three (3) single-spaced pages
- A bibliography of primary and secondary sources in one (1) single-spaced page
- A vita not to exceed two (2) single-spaced pages

These items should be prepared in accordance with the NEH Summer Stipend guidelines found at <http://www.neh.gov/grants/guidelines/stipends.html>.
