NC TEACH Admission Process

PHASE 1: Submit Application

Complete the online Graduate Application (\$55 application fee) available at:
<https://app.applyyourself.com/AYApplicantLogin/ApplicantConnectLogin.asp?id=uncgr-g>

Notify Mrs. Deb Ackerman via email (djackerm@uncg.edu) that you have done so. It is **the candidate's** responsibility to monitor the status of the application* to ensure that all materials are received in a timely manner. Mrs. Ackerman cannot check on the status of forwarded materials.



PHASE 2: Application Review

Once all application materials have been received (i.e., complete application, transcripts, and letters of recommendation), application is reviewed by the Program Coordinator of licensure area.



PHASE 3: Program of Study

Once candidate is approved for admission by Program Coordinator, Graduate School is notified of recommendation and an individualized program of study is developed.

Note: Approximate timeline from when Program Coordinator approves application to when Graduate School is notified of recommendation for admission is **two weeks. If questions or concerns arise during this time, the candidate will be contacted by the NC TEACH Advisor.*



PHASE 4: Graduate School Audit and Final Approval

Graduate School conducts audit of application (typically takes an additional week) and notifies candidate of either full graduate standing admission or provisional admission, meaning that candidate must earn a "B" or better in first two courses.



PHASE 5: Registration Information

NC TEACH office sends email with instructions for registration, including Student ID # and advising codes, as well as a copy of program of study.
