4. **The Individualist-** (Sensitive, Withdrawn), expressive, dramatic, self-absorbed and temperamental.
5. **The Investigator-** (The Intense, Cerebral), perceptive, innovative, secretive and isolated.
6. **The Loyalist-** (The Committed), security-oriented, engaging, responsible, anxious and suspicious.
7. **The Enthusiast-** (The Busy, Fun-Loving), spontaneous, versatile, distractible and scattered
8. **The Challenger-** (The Powerful), dominating, self-effacing, decisive, willful and confrontational.
9. **The Peacemaker-** (The Easygoing) self effacing, receptive, reassuring, agreeable and complacent.

We discussed how each of the groups may react together and a diverse mix is usually the ideal group, since so many different factors are considered.

We also divided into different groups according to the group we placed in, when we took the test. While in the group, we discussed the characteristics of our group.

At the end of the meeting we signed up for the committees, that we would like to participate in this year. The committees are Nominations Committee, Public Relations Committee, Outreach Committee and Employee Enrichment Committee.
