

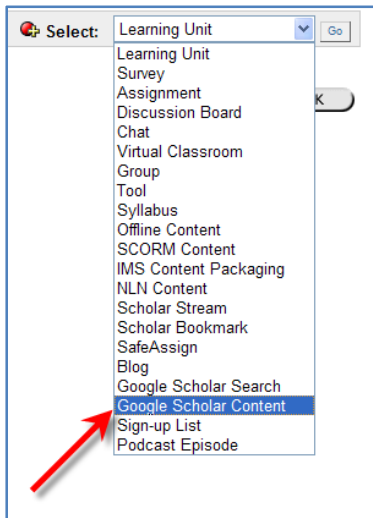


Adding Google Scholar Content to your Blackboard Course

Adding Google Scholar Content will provide students with a link to an article or book which was located through a Google Scholar Search.

To add Google Scholar Content to your course:

1. Select the appropriate content area in which you'd like to store **Google Scholar Content**. Click **Edit View** in the top, right corner.
2. In the dropdown box, select **Google Scholar Content** and click the **Go** button.



3. The next screen that appears will look like this:

4. Find an article that you wish to cite in Blackboard via a Google Scholar search.
5. Once you have returned the results of your search, click the **Import into Blackboard** link below the article you would like to import into Blackboard.
