

Wikis

The students in the MPH class (HEA 601) will be creating wiki pages that describe different settings for working in public health education. There will be a total of 8 wikis created by the 601 students. There will be 2 wikis that focus on public health education in school settings, 2 wikis that focus on public health education in a community setting, 2 wikis that focus on public health education in a workplace setting and 2 wikis that focus on public health education in a healthcare setting.

The 601 students are instructed to create the wiki pages for an audience of undergraduate students who are interested in learning more about a specific setting in terms of employment opportunities. You will review all 8 wikis and complete a feedback form for each wiki. Your feedback will be used in the calculation of the 601 students' grades for the Workforce Wiki assignment.

The Workforce Wikis should provide a general overview of the setting, what types of positions are available in the setting and what experiences and skills are useful to get a job in that setting. The wikis will also include descriptions of working within the setting from interviews with professionals as well as provide you with an understanding of some of the cutting-edge topics in the setting, potential future trends for the setting and ethical considerations that might arise in the setting.

You will be reviewing the wikis for both content (the information provided) and format/delivery (how the wiki works as a webpage, such as use of graphics and ease of navigation). The wikis will be available for you to review on 11/6/08. Each wiki will have a Survey Page, where you will go to access the online survey that will count as your review. Be sure to put your full name and Section # on the survey as your reviews will be sent back to your instructor for grading.
