

Master of Arts in Women's and Gender Studies
Admission Requirements

Students will be admitted to the program on the basis of academic achievement without regard to undergraduate major. Students must provide the following:

1. Transcripts of all previous undergraduate and graduate work sent directly from the school of previous degree(s) with a satisfactory academic standing as an undergraduate: "B" (3.0 GPA) average of better in the undergraduate major.
2. Official GRE* general/GMAT scores taken within the last five years.
3. Three letters of recommendation on the organizations/institution's letter head.
4. Statement of purpose highlighting motivation, specific option/area of interest within the program, relevant experience or background particular to the proposed study.
5. Sample of analytical or professional writing if 5-15 pages.

* GRE/GMAT quantitative scores will be used to evaluate the preparation for MBA and other quantitative courses; appropriate remediation will be recommended if necessary.
