Web Accessibility Coordinators completed the 2007 State of the University Web Accessibility Report which contained the results of an Audit. Roughly 500 webpages have been audited with slightly more than 75% “passing.” It is very hard to find an auditing methodology that does justice to the complexity of the problem of accessibility. All units are different, making coordinating very hard. Systems were not included in the audit. The Report was sent to the Chancellor, VCs and WOC.
